# INDIAN VIBES IN MOSCOW: HISTORY

## GRENADYARD, XVII CENTURY ANCIENT CHAMBERS

The Indian community in Russia is considered one of the oldest in Europe, with Indian traders present in the country since the XVII century. Some historians say that a special inn for merchants from the east was commemorated in the Moscow chambers of the XVII century. This place also hosted Indian traders whose goods were popular among the Muscovites.

## HOTEL "DUSSAULT"

In Moscow history during the Russian Empire, there are several famous Indians who had their destinies surprisingly intertwined with the city. For example, in spring of 1887, the last ruler of the Sikh state, Duleep Singh, stayed at Dussault Hotel in Moscow. Today the building houses the office of the Ministry of Emergency Situations, but Muscovites still remember the luxury and splendor of the hotel that once operated there.

## MOSCOW DRAMA THEATER NAMED AFTER A.S. PUSHKIN

It was Inayat Khan's production of "Shakuntala" that opened the Kamerny Theater in 1914. Over the years, the theater has become one of the most renowned in the capital. Today, it is known as the Moscow Drama Theater, named after A.S. Pushkin.

There were many places in the Soviet Union that were closely connected to India. One of them was Communist University of the Toilers of the East (KUTV), where the first Indian students studied in the 20s of the XX century.

## METROPOL HOTEL MOSCOW 5★

Metropol Hotel was a place of great significance during the revolutionary period. In 1917 it served as a stronghold for resistance against the Bolshevik forces. After Soviet government was established, Metropol became an important place, housing some of the most prominent figures of the new regime. Indian communists also lived in this area, making plans to spread their ideas in their home country. In 1947, the Indian embassy in Moscow was located here during its early days. It was headed by Vijaya Lakshmi Pandit, the sister of Jawaharlal Nehru, the first prime minister of India.

## VTB ARENA (FORMER DYNAMO STADIUM)

In 1955, Jawaharlal Nehru himself along with his daughter Indira Gandhi paid an official visit to Moscow. During his stay he visited many different locations in the city and also performed in front of a large Soviet audience at the Dynamo stadium, now known as VTB Arena. His speech was also attended by representatives of the Indian community, who were saluted by the Prime as "brothers, Soviet Indians!".

This was not the first visit of Nehru to the USSR. The future Prime Minister visited the Soviet Union with his father Motilal Nehru back in 1927. At that time his family stayed at the Grand Hotel, now is known as Four Seasons Hotel near Red Square.

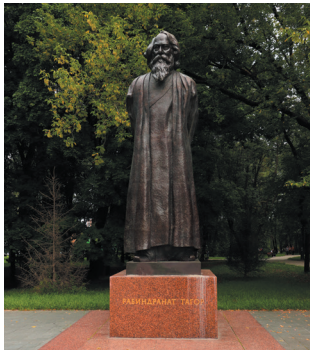

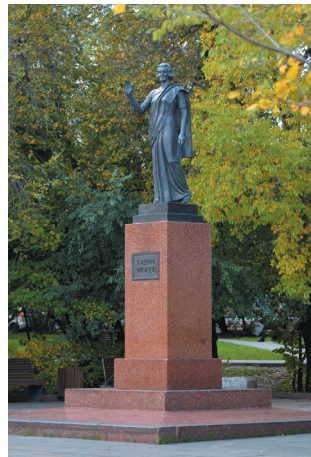

In 1988, a monument to Mahatma Gandhi was also erected near Moscow State University as a gift from the Indian government to the Soviet people.



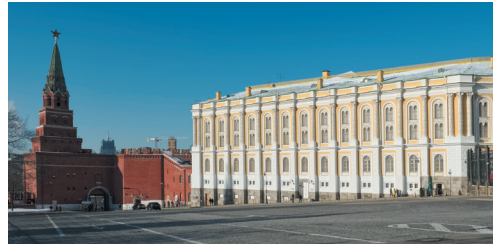

## RED SQUARE

Moscow also preserves the memory of the beginning of space cooperation between India and Russia. The exploration of space by India began with the arrival of the first Indian cosmonaut, Rakesh Sharma, in Moscow in 1982. The photo at Red Square captured these memories. Later, he went to the Baikonur cosmodrome, from where the Soyuz T-11 spacecraft delivered the first Indian astronaut into orbit in 1984 as part of a Soviet crew.

## "ORLOV" DIAMOND, DIAMOND FUND

Moscow is also a city where valuable Indian artifacts are on display. The city often hosts exhibitions of Indian cultural heritage, and the city's museums store various relics. One of the most interesting places is the Diamond Fund of Russia, which is located on the grounds of the Kremlin. Various unique Indian precious stones are kept here. The largest diamond in Diamond Fund collection, the "Orlov" diamond is from India. This diamond has a fascinating history. It traveled between the Great Mughals and the Persian Shahs. In the 17th century, Russian Count Orlov purchased the unique diamond to present it as a gift to the Russian Empress Catherine II. The Empress's royal scepter was decorated with this stone. # IMPORTANT INFO FOR TOURISTS

## APPLY FOR E-VISA

Indian citizens have an opportunity to apply for e-visa to enter Russia. In order to do so, applicants need to fill out an online form and pay a \$52 fee. The approved e-visa will be sent via email within 4 days. The e-visa is valid for tourism, business purposes, and participation in events such as social, political, economic, cultural, scientific, and sporting events. Holders of the e-visa can stay in Russia for up to 30 days from the date of entry.



## EXPLORE DIRECT FLIGHTS TO MOSCOW

The Aeroflot Russian Airlines company operates a daily direct flight between Delhi and Moscow. The airline offers a wide range of services, including the opportunity to order free special meals developed taking into account age, medical indications and religious beliefs.

## EXCHANGE CURRENCY

Don't forget to exchange some money for cash in Russian rubles, as VISA and Mastercard currently do not function in Russia.

Currency exchange offices can be found at Moscow airports.

You can also exchange money at banks or some hotels. There are exchange offices working 24/7 — check the operating hours online.
